

## Trail Town Task Force Committee (TTTFC) Membership

The following are suggested members for your TTTFC membership. All parties will play a crucial role in the assessment, planning, and implementation processes. Committee participation will evolve; go up and down in attendance and interest. Make sure your Catalyst involves them in the areas of their interest and expertise.

**Sponsoring Agency – Catalyst** (Mayor can designate a agency to spearhead the project made up of the following membership)

**Mayor's Office** (integrating TT in town's vision and planning documents, assistance with equipment, expediting plans, exchange of info)

**County Judge's Office** (integrating TT into county's vision and planning documents, assistance with equipment, expediting plans, exchange of info)

**Tourism Commission** (planning and event assistance, marketing dollars, signage, brochure assistance.....)

**Chamber of Commerce** (business network, awareness, can bring businesses needed in)

**MainStreet / Revitalization Programs** (how Trail Town can help area businesses & vice versa)

**County Extension Service** (KY Proud, Farms are Fun, and other grant programs)

**City/county Recreation Boards** (knows recreation needs, has resources)

**Emergency Services Personnel** (input on logistical and informational considerations & awareness)

**PVA Office** (maps of land parcels & who owns them for land permission for trail connectors)

**Planning and Zoning Office** (assistance with zoning area for trail town businesses and trail connectors to be in a particular zoned area to protect the integrity of its purpose and other input)

**Economic Development** (partnership for new businesses coming in to provide trails through their property if needed, input with land owners, can assist in bringing needed businesses in.....)

**State Highway District –** (road cycling, signage, logistical, grant support)

**Ad District** (can provide GPS service for mapping and grants for needed parcels of the project.)

**Trail Users Group / Club's** ( hiking, horseback, cycling...reps needed for insight)

**Art Board** (can assist local businesses in providing local art for souvenirs.....)

**Historical / Genealogy Society** (knowledge of area historical points of interest and trails)

**School Board or school leaders working with:**

- community service
- activity clubs
- "Shop" class or technical skills that involve woodworking, draftsmanship, welding, or metals fabrication.
- Students who work (if there are annual, quarterly or monthly meetings with them) target hospitality training....

**Any city or county organization** omitted by error or you feel will assist

**Invite businesses** who especially cater to adventure services

**Local newspaper** (they go to all governmental, school, and club meetings, a wealth of knowledge)

**Health Department / hospital wellness program** (know health related grants that encourage activities)

Publicize it and invite any interested persons to participate
